Plymouth Community School - Solar Energy Systems:

Project Summary:

- Plymouth Community School Corporation is interested in installing a solar panel array at Washington Elementary and at Riverside Intermediate.
- The corporation is seeking a zoning variance to place the solar arrays within a R-3 zoning as well as a variance to reduce the required vegetive screening requirements on select side of the array that currently contain vegetation.
- The area under and around the proposed solar array will be planted with Indiana native grasses to reduce the need for mowing and will be fully fenced.
- All solar panels are fixed and do not move as the season change.

Planning:

 Per the ordinance the proposed solar array must be screened and not visible from the roadway.

Emergency Services:

Access to the solar array will be through a gate in the fence and will utilize
the same key as the other gates used for Fire Department access.

Transportation:

Access to the fence gate will be grass therefore no driveway is needed.

Utilities:

 There is a large water main that is located along the north side of the proposed Washington Elementary array that runs parallel with the railroad tracks. The developer / installer shall keep a minimum of 20' from the centerline of the water main to any portion of the array components and fencing.

Drainage:

 The Riverside Intermediate array placement will need to be adjusted to avoid the existing drainage basin that is located on the south-west corner of the proposed array.

General:

 After meeting Note: Part of the zoning variance request is to eliminate the required vegetive screening along the east side of the array at the Riverside Intermediate location. It should be noted that the development of the Stump property located to the East will contain homes in the future.
