Commissioners Beth Pinkerton and John Yadon were absent. City Attorney Surrisi, Building Commissioner Hammonds, Clerk-Treasurer Xaver and Plan Consultant Booker were also present.

Commissioners Webster and Secor moved and seconded to approve the minutes of last regular meeting of November 4, 2020, as presented. The motion carried.

Plan Consultant Booker reviewed the findings of fact and proposed changes. He stated that any septic system that would be installed would need to be approved by the county. The Technical Review Committee reviewed the matter on November 10, 2020 and they had no questions or comments.

Robert Deon, 13540 5D Rd, voiced a concern on how most of this property was wetland. He also believed that the property should only be set up for two houses. Another problem that he had what that the property is all in the flood zone. Booker responded that each plat would need to get permits from the county to build any building on the property.

Karen Deon, 13540 5D Rd, stated that she was worried about the extra traffic in the area if houses were to be built on this property. Feece replied that there should not be much more traffic than what is already on the road. Booker added that there could only be one house put on each lot after approval.

Mr. & Mrs. Deon asked who signed the application as Mary Lou Fritz has passed away and Don Fritz is bedridden. Feece looked at the application and found that the step-son had power of attorney and he was the one who filed the application.

There being no further questions or comments, Commissioners Webster and Gidley moved and seconded to close the public hearing. The motion carried.

Gidley asked if there were houses in front of lot 3. Booker confirmed this and added that there is only 50 feet of the property touching the road which is the city minimum.

Webster was not happy that there was not a representative for this application present. Walters agreed with Webster and stated that they would prefer to table this case.

Commissioners Webster and Gidley moved and seconded to table PC 2020-12 until the next meeting. The motion passed by roll call vote:
