

## REGULAR SESSION, BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY, January 10, 2022

The Board of Public Works and Safety of Plymouth, Indiana, met in Regular Session at 6:00 p.m. on January 10, 2022. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers, on the second floor of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan St., Plymouth, Indiana.

Mayor Senter called the meeting to order. Senter presided for Board Members Duane Culp, Shiloh Milner, Bill Walters, and Jeff Houin who were physically present. City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Gorski were also present. The public was able to see and hear the meeting through Microsoft Teams.

Board Members Culp and Milner moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the Regular Session meeting of December 27, 2021. The motion carried.

Utility Superintendent Donnie Davidson requested the board's permission to solicit quotes to replace ¾ ton pick-up trucks at the Water and Waste Water departments.

Board Members Houin and Culp moved and seconded to approve the request. The motion carried.

Street Superintendent Marquardt requests permission to award bids for 2022 Street Materials. After reviewing the bids the two from Stockberger and IMI will be awarded. He believes that it would be best to stay with the two local bids as we have in the past.

Board Members Culp and Milner moved and seconded to award 2022 Street Material bids. The motion carried.

Marquardt states that he has been in discussion with the Fuel bid Company and they are currently watching prices since they jumped shortly after the bid was announced.

Marquardt states that the Street Department doesn't have a big snow plow truck in the budget for this year but he is looking for permission to start that process. He would like to go with Sourcewell Bidding as they have done in the past. He doesn't know if he will even see a truck this year but he would like permission to get it started.

Board Members Houin and Senter moved and seconded to approve the request. The motion carried.

Board Members Culp and Milner moved and seconded to allow for the payroll for January 14, 2022 and the claims for January 10, 2022, as entered in Claim Register #2022-1. The motion carried.
